RISK ASSESSMENT SHEET

Frequency of use Daily / AS REQUIRED

1. **PEOPLE AT RISK** (instructors, visitors, campers, schools, public)
Number of people involved 1 - 15
2. **HAZARDS** (Anything with the potential to cause harm)
 - a) Toxic/stale air/heat
 - b) Debris, obstructions
 - c) Impact with structure or other users
 - d) Claustrophobia/panic
 - e) Too many participants for activity/distraction from other site users
3. **ASSESSMENT OF RISK**

4. **LIST MEASURES TAKEN TO CONTROL HAZARDS**

 - d) Brief participants before start and ask relevant questions, provide reassurance and inform of escape route
 - e) Follow guidance on appropriate number of participants, use support staff to monitor pedestrian traffic
