Grand Howl and Welcome 15 minutes	Discussion: What does conservation mean to you? Create a spider diagram in the group showing ideas.	Large paper, pens
Group work 30 minutes	Design a garden that will promote good conservation practice such as plants that attract bees and areas for nesting.	Creative resources
Game 25 minutes	Scavenger hunt: Create a scavenger hunt for the children so that they can explore their outdoor environment.	Scavenger hunt list
Discussion 15 minutes	What did we find that didn't belong outside? Links to green cross code	None
Grand howl and Prayer 5 minutes	Reflective prayer relevant to programme	Prayer
